

- 8. Village Lighting- meeting with Rutland County Council – Cllr Shuttleworth**
The meeting was advised that RCC are planning to transfer costs of lighting to Parish and Town Councils with the old style lighting to be changed to LED.

- 9. Bus Shelter damage to panes on Littleworth Lane**
The damage to the bus shelter panes of glass. A recommendation was made for these to be changed from glass to acrylic with two panes of 3mm costing £31.49. The broken panes were removed by RCC and it is understood they have no imminent plans to replace them.

- 10. Planning issues: No permission: 4 Main Street. New Build Littleworth Lane**
The meeting asked the Clerk to contact RCC Planning and advise that despite invitations extended to the applicants at the request of RCC, they have had no contact from them and verify if this is still to be treated as a retrospective.
New build on Littleworth Lane: The PC are currently advised that the features being developed do not match the original: windows in roof with space for bedrooms; proper obscured glass rather than plastic overlay which can be immediately removed with the whole episode causing all neighbours concern and distress. Damaged caused o access and roadway verge; personal safety and that of livestock and horses at risk and the enjoyment of the amenity being non-existent. The PC is grateful for the time and effort spent by Planning but to advise them of our concerns requesting urgent attention. It is also felt that if at all possible the builder should cease work forthwith until the relevant planning has been agreed with a letter to this effect to be sent to the head of RCC copied to Planning.

- 11. Business to be taken forward to the next PC Meeting**
 - a)The attention of the meeting was drawn to the Highway outside Willow House on Littleworth Lane
 - b)Boss Stone who are driving too fast along Lambley Lodge Lane – the suggestion being the Clerk contact a previous Councillor who is likely to have contact details
