1) The matter of the claim for the damage to the Village Hall, now, we are advised settled . This is reflected in our bank statement for January.

1) We have a quote from Oakham Gardening for £17.50 per hour with an estimated 2 hour mow time at £35.00 per alternate weeks cut. Hedges would be three times a year at £87.50 and cut to 'best fit'. Weeding and any other maintenance or additional work charged at £17.50 per hour.  
2) Andrew Carter has confirmed he would be happy to continue at last year's rates of £42.00 per cut to include weeding, strimming at mowing alternate weeks and hedges at £50 per cut twice per year.
